



GETTING READY FOR CAMP FLIX!

WHAT PARENTS AND CAMPERS NEED TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO CAMP FLIX

This packet contains information you need for Camp Flix this summer! We are looking forward to a great summer season! If you have any questions for us, please email us at tkarsch@campflix.com or call us at **404-863-6778**.

Included within this packet is a Camp Flix Health Form that should be brought with your camper to the first day of camp along with a copy of their latest physical examination. **DO NOT mail or fax these forms to our home office.** Your child will not be able to participate in camp activities unless all forms are presented at check-in.

OVERVIEW - CAMP FLIX DAY CAMP (AGES 11-17)

- Monday drop-off is between 8:00am and 9:00am. Please remember to bring a signed Camp Flix Health Form and copy of your camper's last physical and give them to administrator on-site. Please do not e-mail or fax these to us in advance.
- Tuesday – Friday drop-off occurs anytime between 8:30am and 9:00am. Please do not drop-off before 8:30am, there will be no supervision available. Camp activities begin at 9:00am.
- Campers are not allowed to leave campus for lunch. If your son/daughter is driving to/from camp, we need to have written approval from a parent.
- You may purchase lunch for your child when you register. Emory Day Campers can purchase a 5-day lunch plan for \$55 and Oglethorpe Day Campers can purchase a week-long pass for \$45. Both schools offer an all-you-can-eat buffet lunch with vegetarian options. You also have the option of packing a lunch for your child.
- Important! Please do not send perishable items such as milk, eggs, poultry, fish, etc with your camper, as we do not have any resources to keep these items at their proper temperature.
- Pick-up on Monday thru Thursday is at 4:30pm. On Friday, we have our Red Carpet Walk (5:30pm) followed by our Grand Finale where all of the camper films will be shown. Program will start at 6:00pm and last approximately 2 hours.

OVERVIEW - OVERNIGHT CAMPERS (AGES 11-17)

- Sunday drop-off is between 4:00pm and 5:30pm. Please remember to bring all appropriate forms signed and provide to Camp Flix Administrator onsite. Once checked-in, you will be escorted by a Camp Flix staffer to your camper's dorm room. Dinner is at 6:00pm.
- Pick-up is immediately following the Red Carpet Premiere on Friday evening. Overnight campers will pack up their bags prior to the Friday night premiere and will be able to pick them up from their rooms. Campers must turn-in their keys and/or keycards to the onsite Camp Flix administrator before leaving or they will be charged by the school.
- All meals are provided beginning with dinner on Sunday night and ending with our pre-premiere pizza party on Friday evening. The cafeterias at both of our venues, Emory and Oglethorpe, provide vegetarian options. Please advise us in advance of any other food allergies or restrictions.
- Your filmmaker needs to bring:
 - A week's worth of clothes
 - Clothes for the Friday Night Premiere
 - A pillow, pillow case, 2 twin flat sheets, a towel, washcloth and blanket.
 - Toiletries and hygiene supplies: (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
 - Dollar bills or change for vending machines
 - Campers are welcome to bring cell phones, iPads, etc....but do so at their own risk. Camp Flix is not responsible for the loss of any personal belongings.



FOR ALL CAMPS:

Health Forms and Medication:

In order for your child to attend camp you must bring two forms/reports to camp on the first day. You must fill out and sign the attached Camp Flix Health Form AND you must also provide a copy of your son/daughter's most recent physical exam, signed by a licensed physician.

Please note that no OTC medications will be dispensed without the permission of the campers' parent or guardian. Ibuprofen and Aspirin are available but will not be given unless indicated on their health form that we can do so, in other cases we will call to ask your permission first. If your camper has a health related issue during camp hours they will be brought to the Camp Administrator and if needed, you will be contacted. In the case of an emergency, 911 will be called for help and the parents will be called to notify them of the situation. Please note that there is no licensed physician or nurse on campus.

Friday Night Red Carpet Premiere:

Beginning at 5:30pm, the camper filmmaking crews will walk the red carpet and pose for pictures by the paparazzi (you!) along the way. Showtime will begin at 6:00pm and will last approximately two hours. Parking may be limited so please consider carpooling and arriving early. Camper films will be available for digital download (for free) a few weeks after camp is over.

As we get closer to camp, we will provide you with the e-mail and phone information for all Camp Flix staff including the Director and Assistant Director. If your camper is arriving late or needs to be picked up early, please contact one of the camp staff so we can make proper arrangements.

CELL PHONE POLICY

We do allow campers to bring cell phones to camp but they do so at their own risk. We will be setting guidelines about when they can and cannot be used with the campers on the first day and those guidelines will be enforced by our counselors and instructors during the week. We ask that day campers do not bring any other cameras, Ipads, Ipods, laptops, etc. . . . unless approved by their counselor. Overnight campers can bring them and leave in dorm room but they do so at their own risk and Camp Flix is not responsible if they are lost, stolen or damaged.
